## Main Heading: Kids Transformed by God

Unique July Description: July Can Be Weird... YFC begins a new fiscal year on July 1st (that is why we reset impact reporting in July). Of course, spiritual transformation does not follow our YFC calendar. For example, when Shawna becomes a follower of Jesus in May but does not get involved in a local fellowship until July your numbers might look like 0 in the first box and 1 in the third box. That's okay!

Ongoing Monthly Description: It is intuitive to report the number of new believers, kids plugged into a local fellowship and the number of teenagers beginning a Christ-sharing relationship with a lost friend but understanding discipleship warrants further explanation for consistent data reporting. Reported discipleship relationships should be characterized by teenagers in a mutually agreed relationship with a leader meeting regularly (at least twice per month) and ongoing. The conversations involved in these discipleship relationships should be real, open and honest while focused on prayer, scripture and life-issues of the teen.
